

Camping Rules and Regulations

- ❖ Camping fees charged are for all related camping expenses, such as park ground space, water, electricity, trash pick-up, showers, privies and other. Please be conscientious.
- ❖ For those that pay their own camping and register separately from the Artisan or Food Vendor application please sign-up on to the Eventeny.com application. You must ask your employers their booth/cart/gamer name as it appears on eventeny.com to sign-up correctly. Select the Camping application.
- ❖ Only one camper van, RV **or** tent per camp site
- ❖ Camping vehicles are: RV, Travel Trailer, Converted vans or Pop-ups
- ❖ A maximum of 4 adults per camping site assigned, lot size is approximately 20' wide by 30' deep or 20' X 40', based on fees paid.
- ❖ To approve multiple campers (2-4 people) in the same camp site, they must stay in the same tent or Camper. Tents are limited to a single (one) tent, which can accommodate one camper or a tent accommodating up to a maximum of 4-people, **per camp site**. If the 4 approved campers own two 2-person sleeper tents; the two tents will be allowed in the camp site with appropriate authorization.
- ❖ Primary camper must add additional campers to his application and must indicate who the additional camper works for if it is a different employer. Only one credit card should be used for total amount due.
- ❖ Camping fees:
 - Under 20' is \$275.00
 - 20' & over is \$375.00
 - Additional campers age 10 and older are \$85.00 each
 - Clean-up deposit \$100.00
 - Pets \$10.00 each
 - 20amps Electric is \$375.00 for one outlet plug
 - 30amps Electric is \$475.00 for one outlet plug
 - Numbered tie-on electric connections are mandatory

Camping Rules and Regulations

- Piggy backing electricity is strictly prohibited and will result in dismissal from the Festival
- Campers must park their cars, vans, SUV's Pickups, Motorcycles in designated parking area with a green Parking Pass
- ❖ Obey speed limit & do NOT avoid dips. Fines and/or forfeiture of security deposits apply. If you're asked to slow down, just wave & say thank you.
- ❖ DO NOT cross the snow fencing perimeter of campground. Signs are posted to keep unauthorized people from trespassing. Use the proper entrances to access campground & close gate behind you. If you see someone that you don't think belongs, ask to see pass and/or contact Camp manager.
- ❖ Smoking in port-a-johns or shower trailer is prohibited.
- ❖ NO DUMPING of grey or black tanks. Contact pump-out Company to arrange for these to be emptied properly.
- ❖ Respect & adhere to Quiet Time hours:
 - Festival Days: 10pm - 7am
 - Non-festival Days: 10pm - 8am
 - Exceptions can be made if advance notice & permission of surrounding neighbors & campground manager are approved.
 - When using a generator, be mindful of the noise & where the emissions are being directed. If you can, please turn off during quiet hours.
- ❖ All camp trash must go directly to dumpsters
 - This is to keep unwanted critters, i.e. raccoons, feral cats & coyotes from coming into the campground.
- ❖ Bulk trash such as furniture, tires, car batteries, chemicals, etc. may NOT be thrown in the dumpsters NOR left in the Park as freebies.
- ❖ Recycle bins are for EMPTY plastic bottles & aluminum cans ONLY.
- ❖ No parking on side of road opposite of wall in Primitive. This is PER Quiet Waters Park. You will be fined by The County. This is for the benefit of the trees. Due to the coral bed 6-8in below topsoil, the roots of trees must grow out instead of down, therefore

making their root system close to surface. Daily vehicle traffic traumatizes the root systems & damages the trees. Drive on/drop off is acceptable.

- ❖ No tying off on the trees. Again, this traumatizes the trees & can cause permanent damage.
- ❖ Curb your pet. This is not only campground policy it is also the law. Dog waste contains harmful bacteria & is a breeding ground for Parvo. This poses health risks to you, your pet & the community. Cats and dogs must have current vaccination records, pet registration form filled out, and fees paid. Please provide an up to date vaccination record to Campground manager. Dogs must always be leashed/tethered/kenneled and dogs and cats with access to shade & fresh water.
- ❖ Broward County Sheriff's Office Police rides through campground from time to time to make sure that this is adhered to & followed.
